

Errorless Learning Worksheets

This targeted intervention helps students build fluency with basic facts (addition, subtraction, multiplication, or division) and encourages automatic learning without testing.

Materials:

- Teacher-created worksheet with answer key displayed at the top of the page

Steps:

1. The teacher provides the student with a worksheet and directs the student to complete the math facts as quickly as possible.
2. If the student comes to a math fact that is not known, the student locates the problem and its correct answer in the key at the top of the page and writes it in.
