

## SAFI: Student Checklist

1. Create a “daily stack” by taking 7 flash cards from your **known** deck and 3 flash cards from your **unknown** deck. Shuffle them together.
2. Take the first card from the top of the daily stack and place it flat on the table.
3. Read the math fact on the flash card and write the answer on the dry-erase board within 3 seconds.
4. Turn the flash card over and compare the answer that you wrote to the answer on the back of the card.
5. If your answer is correct, place that card in the **daily known** pile.
6. If your answer is incorrect, place that card into the **daily unknown** pile.
7. Once you have gone through all 10 cards, take the **daily unknown** pile and practice writing each math fact and correct answer on your dry-erase board three times.
8. Shuffle the 10 cards again and go through steps 2 through 7 until you can answer all 10 cards without an error in a single run-through.
9. Place the 10 cards into the **known** deck and shuffle the cards together.
10. Place rubber bands around the **known** deck and **unknown** deck to keep and use in the next intervention session.
