Standard K.CC.1. Count to 100 by ones and by tens.

Key Elements:

This rote counting is an oral and auditory skills.

Students can count by ones in sequence up to 10.

Students can count by ones in sequence up to 11-20.

Students can count by ones in sequence 20-100.

Students can count by tens in sequence from 10-100.

Then students can count up to 100.

Ideas for teaching:

- · Rote counting while exercising
- Use music, poems, chants, rhymes, or literature that encourages counting
- Practice counting during transitions
- Count days up to 100 days.
